Town of Sturgeon Bay Ordinance Door County, Wisconsin Ordinance No. 01 - 2018

All-Terrain and Utility-Terrain Vehicle Routes

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING ALL-TERRAIN AND UTILITY-TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTES AND REGULATING THE OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN AND UTILITY-TERRAIN VEHICLES IN THE TOWN OF STURGEON BAY, DOOR COUNTY, WISCONSIN.

INTENT – The Town of Sturgeon Bay, Door County, Wisconsin adopts the following all-terrain/utility-terrain vehicle routes for the operation of all-terrain/utility-terrain vehicles upon the roadways as identified in "Routes" section below.

STATUTORY AUTHORITY – This route is created pursuant to the town board under section 1.1.01 as authorized by 23.33(8)(b), Wis. Stats.

The applicable provisions of 23.33 regulating ATV/UTV operation pursuant to routes are adopted.

ROUTES – The following roads are designated as routes:

- A. All "town roads" south of the shipping channel.
- B. Said routes are further identified by the attached map.
- C. Does not include County roads, other than at intersections.

CONDITIONS — As a condition for the use of this route, the following conditions shall apply to all operators (and passengers);

- A. The applicable provisions of Wis. Stats. Section 23.33 regulating ATV/UTV operation are adopted.
- B. All ATV/UTV operators shall operate at the lesser of 30 miles per hour or the posted speed limit.
- C. All ATV/UTV operators shall slow the vehicle to 20 mph or less when operating within 150 ft. of a dwelling.
- D. All ATV/UTV operators shall ride in single file.
- E. All ATV/UTV operators shall be licensed drivers with a current, valid driver's license.
- F. All ATV/UTV's must be registered with license plate on vehicle
- G. Routes must be signed in accordance with NR 64.12, and NR 64.12(7)c.

ENFORCEMENT – This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

PENALTIES – Wisconsin state All-Terrain/Utility-Terrain Vehicle penalties as found in s.23.33(13)(a) Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

SEVERABILITY – The provision of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other person's circumstances shall not be deemed affected.

EFFECTIVE DATE – This ordinance shall take effect and the day following its publication.
